MEET RULES AND INFORMATION

1. The competition is a Level 3 licensed meet, held under ASA Laws and ASA Technical Rules.
2. The promoter is Andrew Farrow on behalf of Hemel Hempstead SC.
3. All swimmers must be Category 2 ASA registered or members of SASA or WASA.
4. Age as at September 23rd 2017.
5. The competition comprises the 200 fly.
6. The cost of entry will be as follows
 - a) Each participating club will pay Hemel Hempstead SC the lesser of £50 or an equal share of the costs for any number of swimmers to participate in the event.
 - b) Individual swimmers may enter at a cost of £10 per entry which will be used to reduce the overall cost of the event for participating clubs.
7. All entries must be made using Hy-Tek's Team Manager or TM Lite. Completed electronic entry files should be submitted to entries@hpsc.org.uk as should all enquiries concerning the competition. Confirmation of accepted entries will be communicated to the participating clubs and individual swimmers.
8. An upper cut-off time of 1:48.56 will apply for swimmers of both genders and all age groups. Any swimmer who has a time faster than or equal to the upper cut-off time is not eligible to swim. Entries with no times or estimated times will be accepted.
9. The closing date for entries is midnight Saturday 9th September 2017. Entries will be accepted after the closing date if the event is under subscribed.
10. The Promoter reserves the right to limit the number of entries to comply with time limits. Priority will be given to members of Berkhamsted SC, City of St Albans SC, Harpenden SC, Hemel Hempstead SC, Stevenage SC, Tring SC and Watford SC. Thereafter entries will be accepted from other clubs in order of receipt: that is, first come, first served. If it is necessary to reject entries, swimmers whose entry times are slowest in relation to the 2018 Hertfordshire County Championship qualifying times will be rejected and their clubs informed.
11. The pool is 25m and anti-wave devices will be in place.
12. Once an entry has been accepted a competitor shall swim or give notice of withdrawal. Notice of withdrawals from a club shall be reported to the recorders at least 30 minutes before the start of the session.
13. Over the top starts may be used at the referee's discretion.
14. Swimmers will be seeded into heats based on entry times - heats will be swum as mixed gender, age and club.
15. Results will be declared by club; each participating club is responsible for setting and communicating an awards policy for their swimmers subject only to the requirement that the competition is age group-based.
16. Results will be posted on the Hemel Hempstead SC website and supplied to British Swimming for entry into the national ranking database.
17. Any person wishing to engage in video or still photography must conform to the recommendations of the ASA Child Protection Policy. The rules on photography apply to swimmers, coaches, team managers, officials and volunteers as well as spectators, and to the use of mobile phones, tablets or other image-capturing electronic

devices as well as cameras. Photography in the changing rooms is absolutely forbidden by both the Club and the swimming pool management.

- 18.** All participants must observe the safety precautions in operation at Hemel SportSpace. Neither the Promoter nor Hemel Hempstead Swimming Club will be responsible for any loss or damage occurring during this meet.
- 19.** Entries to this meet will be held on a computer and consent, as required by Data Protection Act 1998, to the holding of personal information on computer will be deemed to have been given by the submission of the entry. Personal data will be available for inspection during the meet on application to the Promoter.
- 20.** Entry to the spectator gallery may be restricted.
- 21.** Any matter not covered by these conditions will be determined by the Promoter and Referee, subject to ASA Laws, Regulations and the ASA Technical Rules of Racing.
